

Exam Procedures

All candidates are to arrive 1 hour before exam preferably with hair already done.

No jewellery, make-up (seniors may have light make-up), tattoos, nail varnish or underwear (leotards are like swimsuits). Older students please make sure any upper underwear is fully concealed.

Hair:

- Ballet- hair must be worn in a bun (no fringe)
- Tap- hair must be neat and tidy preferably in a French plait
- Modern- hair must be in French plaits
- Boys hair should be neat and if long will need a hair band

Dress code:

Ballet:

- Pre-Primary to Primary: lilac leotard and skirt. Pink ballet socks and pink shoes
- Grade 1 to 5: Lavender leotards, character skirt and shoes
- Grade 1 to 3: Pink socks and pink elasticated shoes
- Grade 4 & 5: Ballet tights and ribbons on shoes

Boys:

- Pre-Primary and Primary: Well fitted blue or white t-shirt with navy or black shorts. White or black shoes with white socks.
- Grade 1 to 3: White short sleeved leotard or well fitted t-shirt with navy or black shorts (navy stirrup tights may be worn instead of shorts). White socks and shoes.
- Grade 4 & 5: White short sleeved leotard or well fitted t-shirt tucked into navy stirrup tights. White socks and white shoes.

Modern:

- Primary to Grade 3: Purple leotard and purple tights (footless or stirrup)
- Grade 4 & 5: Purple leotard and black leggings
- Grade 6 +: Black leotard and leggings

Boys:

- Black jazz pants and purple lycra top

Tap:

- Primary to Grade 5: Purple leotard and tan tights (NO Gusset)
- Intermediate: Black leotard and tan tights (no gusset)

Boys:

- Black jazz pants and purple lycra top
